Nicolas Sarkozy served as the 23rd President of the French Republic (2007 to 2012). 

Forum de la Ville - Data and cities

The Champs Elysées Committee entrusted the agency PCA Stream and its architect Philippe Chiambaretta to imagine a complete redevelopment the avenue, its gardens and its squares (Place de la Concorde, Place de l'Etoile). The ensuing project, called "reenchanting the Champs-Elysées" was shown to the public at the Pavillon de l'Arsenal, in Paris, and was voted on by 100 000 participants through the online platform make.org. The project has been endorsed by the Mayor of Paris

The study drawn up by the architect is based on a robust scientific approach, with data points from several different sources : car and pedestrian traffic, ad hoc opinion surveys, noise and atmospheric pollution, post-project traffic simulation, etc...The underlying idea is that data should help city planners to enhance a city's attractiveness, its inclusiveness and its sustainability. It should also help to measure the impact of urban developments through a test and learn process.


